CAROLE STARTED WORKING AS AN ARCHITECT AFTER GRADUATING FROM THE TOULOUSE SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE IN 2002. From 2008 on, she became interested in jewellery making while working as an architect in Barcelona. MAKING JEWELLERY ALLOWED HER TO WORK WITH HER HANDS IN A WAY SHE COULDN'T WITH ARCHITECTURE AND IS MORE IMMEDIATE GIVEN THAT JEWELLERY IS CREATED MORE QUICKLY once designed. Her skills as an architect in imagining and DRAWING, AND HER APPRECIATION OF MATERIALS AND HARMONIES BETWEEN SHAPES, MEANT SHE COULD DESIGN JEWELLERY. After all, Jewellery, Like spaces, is designed for humans. THE ONLY DIFFERENCE IS THE SCALE.

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
Esna

ESNA, THE NAME OF AN ANCIENT EGYPTIAN CITY LOCATED IN THE VALLEY OF THE KINGS.

The Esna collection was based on the illustration of a braid – a characteristic of childhood in Ancient Egypt.

This inspiration bestowed upon the jewellery in the Esna collection a clever and attractive play on curves.









Monjoie

Amidst the vines, small structures have stood in place since The Narbo Martius times, marking out the path of a former AQUEDUCT THAT USED TO SUPPLY NARBONNE WITH WATER FROM THE SPRINGS IN FONTFROIDE.

IN THE COUNTRYSIDE, THESE SMALL, ALIGNED SHAPES ARE AN ODDITY AND ARE MEANINGFUL IN LIGHT OF THEIR MATERIAL.

They are the Monjoie aedicula in France's Corbières region. The Jewellery in the Monjoie Collection pays homage to these SYMBOLIC STRUCTURES AND IS AN EXPRESSION OF THE UNION BETWEEN ARCHITECTURE AND JEWELLERY.








Amidst thOnou is the name the Greeks gave the ANCIENT EGYPTIAN CITY OF HELIOPOLIS.

The city of the sun.






Pyrgi

Taken from the name of the village of Pyrgi on the island of Chios in the Aegean Sea.

This community is one-of-a-kind with its coloured façades, plastered with lime and then carved to create geometric patterns.

This astounding décor changes the perception of the building's volumes and even those of public spaces.

The Pyrgi collection is thus a work that focuses on geometry, lattices and relief, creating an optical illusion whether you look up close or from Afar.





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
